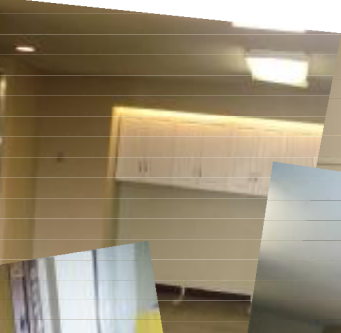
Daffodil Office makes a Move!!!
